Travelling to the conference hotel

Arriving by air

Please note there are two airports in Warsaw, WAW - Warsaw Chopin

Airport and WMI Warsaw-Modlin Mazovia Airport

WAW – Taxis are available at the airport, and you should expect a fare to be in the region of 40–45 Polish Zloty (€10.00). The transfer time is approximately 20–30 minutes.

WMI – Taxis are available at the airport, and you should expect a fare to be in the region of 100–110 Polish Zloty (€26). The transfer time is approximately 40–50 minutes.

If you are wishing to travel by taxi why not utilize EMWA's social media options to pre-arrange to share a taxi with EMWA colleagues arriving at a similar time.

Driving to Warsaw

Car parking is available at the hotel at a cost of 15 PLN per hour or 120 PLN daily payable at the hotel itself.

off in all workshops and other sessions.


Electric Current: Electricity in Warsaw is the European standard 220 Volt
